Jesus carries his cross	Burden	Responsibility	Etc etc	Etc etc	
Jesus falls for the first time	Loss of standing/supports	Isolation, loneliness, vulnerability			
Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus carry Cross	Burden	Shared responsibility			
Jesus falls for second time	Loss of standing/supports	Isolation, loneliness, vulnerability			
Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem	Anthropomorphication	Relationship with a personal stereotype			
Jesus falls for the third time	Loss of standing/supports	Isolation, loneliness, vulnerability			
Jesus is stripped of his clothes	Burdens, containers	Vulnerability, freedom/liberty			
Jesus is nailed to the cross	The Hurts, plus Elevations (status)	Importance being the death of identity			
Jesus dies on the cross	The Hurts, living death metaphor	Death of false identity			
Jesus is taken down from the cross	Loss of status	Humiliation, mortality, coming down to earth, being an ordinary man			
Jesus is laid in the tomb	Container	Connection with family identity			
*Resurrection of Jesus	The Hurts (enlightenment)	Emergence of true identity
